BOARD VACANCIES

Pursuant to *The Illinois School Code*, elective board positions become vacant in the event of one (1) or more of the following conditions prior to expiration of the term of such office:

1. Death of the incumbent.
2. Resignation in writing filed with the Secretary of the Board.
3. Becoming a person under legal disability.
4. Ceasing to be an inhabitant of the District.
5. Conviction of an infamous crime, or of any offense involving a violation of an official oath.
6. Removal from office.
7. Removal pursuant to a decision of a competent tribunal declaring the election void.
8. Ceasing to reside in the sub-district from which any member was elected.
 - a. Any board member who is living outside of their sub-district shall ~~must~~ immediately inform the Superintendent and other board members at the next regularly scheduled board meeting.
 - b. The board vacancy is effective immediately. Once the Superintendent and board members are informed, a letter of resignation may be submitted, but will not be effective upon a future date, as recommended by the Illinois Council of School Attorneys for the Illinois Association of School Boards.
 - c. The board member of the vacated seat will no longer participate in executive session, public session, negotiations, other related subcommittees, or any other official duties as a board member.
 - d. The board member must ~~turn in~~ return district-owned equipment immediately, but ~~not longer than 10 days after vacancy~~ within 10 days of the occurrence of a vacancy.
